Interment Rights

The location to which an Interment Right relates is suitable for one body. An Interment Right includes the right to erect a monument. The cemeteries' Rules limit the size and the types of memorials permitted, as well as images and inscriptions permitted on memorials.

Monument Levies *(which are required Care & Maintenance Fund contributions)*

All of the cemetery's fees, due at the time of interment, and listed above, must be paid in full before a permit for the erection of an upright monument or an inscription on an existing monument will be approved.
